From beginner to the most advanced levels, the French Ministry of National Education offers a wide range of qualifications in French as a foreign language, with diplomas and tests to confirm French language skills. France Éducation international, a national public institution, is responsible for managing the teaching and administration.

The service is suitable for all ages and all groups of people. These qualifications have been designed according to scientific criteria and are standardised on the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages* scale (CEFR).

The diplomas (DEL, DALF) are independent and validate mastery of listening and reading comprehension and speaking and writing skills. They are valid for an unlimited period of time.

These qualifications, validated by psychometrists and assessment experts, are internationally recognised and frequently used by foreign Ministries.

The DELF-DALF network is made up of over 1,200 examination centres in 172 countries.

The France Éducation international services in charge of the diplomas and tests are ISO 9001 certified, guaranteeing the quality of their design and management processes.

DEL

F covers 4 of the 6 language skill levels of the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages* (CEFR).

It is often required for studying at French-speaking universities, especially at the B2 level. Many employers also accept the DEL

F as proof of language skills for working in a Francophone environment. In addition, the DELF B1 is accepted as proof of language proficiency when applying for French nationality. It is also useful for learners who want to measure their progress and have an internationally recognized diploma.

The DAL

F validates levels C1 and C2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

Many Grandes Écoles accept DAL

F C1 or C2 as proof of French proficiency, often waiving language entrance exams for degree programs.

- C1 is for most academic programs
- C2 is for highly competitive or linguistically demanding programs (e.g., literature, law)

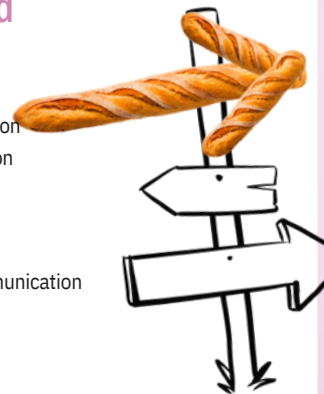

The DEL

F junior/scolaire tests offer subjects and audio and written material suitable for this age and for the interests of the candidates. They lead to the awarding of DELF diplomas which receive the same recognition as the examinations intended for adults.

Abroad, the DEL

F "scolaire" falls under the responsibility of collaboration between French embassies and local education authorities. The sessions are organised in public and private educational establishments.
